## **Project description:**

ICAP at Columbia University, a global health leader situated within the Columbia University Mailman School of Public Health in New York City, initiated ICAP technical assistant program to support HIV response in achieving 95-95-95 global targets for HIV epidemic control in Myanmar since 2014.

## **Overall Job Functions:**

Under the direct supervision of the Technical Director – Strategic Information, the incumbent will provide technical assistance (TA) focusing on HIV- related monitoring and evaluation (M&E) activities. This role involves supporting key stakeholders, including community and key population networks in strengthening the system and capacity on M&E, and upgrading the national databases for improvement, in close collaboration with the ICAP technical teams and key technical partners. The position requires a mix of M&E, public health and Information Technology /Informatics skills. The incumbent will work 5 days a week, with regular reporting of working schedule to the supervisor.

## Brief description of duties and responsibilities

## Technical Assistance

- Support ICAP technical team in evaluating project performance, analyzing project trends over time, and highlighting key achievements by preparing slide decks for periodic progress monitoring.
- Ensure timely development of analytic visualization and provision of technical insights for HIV, drug treatment, and other databases on DHIS2 platforms in collaboration with technical partners.
- Provide TA support in M&E related trainings, review meetings and workshops in collaboration with ICAP technical team.
- Provide TA, in collaboration with ICAP technical team, in revision and development of national HIV M&E tools including guidelines, forms, registers, training materials and other strategic information (SI) related technical documents
- Provide technical support in development and updating analytic dashboards in Drug Treatment Information System (DTIS), DHIS2 online platform and lab quality monitoring tools
- In partnership with other TA partners, provide TA in troubleshooting HIV database and the DHIS2 online platforms.
- Participate in the core technical team for DTIS and coordinate with other technical partners in expanding DTIS implementation
- Provide support in establishment of service progress milestones and oversee the performance of M&E/SI service contractors.
- Support SI team in providing TA for the assessment, implementation of survey and surveillance activities.

## Coordination and Representation

- Support SI team in coordinating with M&E and SI technical partners and obtaining up-todate information on HIV, harm reduction and HIV laboratory related eHealth advancement
- Represent the ICAP team at M&E and SI related events at sub-national and national level as required.

## Reporting and Planning

- Provide support in data extraction for reporting and assist supervisor in preparing reports to key stakeholders.
- Support in monitoring of progress towards ICAP's objectives and milestones in accordance with workplan regularly and for quarterly and annual reports.
- Provide regular reporting on progress of the M&E/SI activities to the supervisor.
- Participate in project activity planning, including budget preparation and reporting.
